## French Language Content by Year Group

### YEAR 3 BLEU

#### Phonics

- Introduce some phonemes and accompanying graphemes
- Read aloud familiar words

#### Grammar

- High frequency verbs
- Gender of nouns
- Simple question form
- Simple sentence

#### Vocabulary

- Vocabulary from different word classes
- Vocabulary which includes key phonemes

#### Skills

- Listening, speaking, reading and writing (sometimes from memory) single words
- Find meanings of words in bi-lingual dictionary

#### Songs, stories and rhymes

- Rhymes, songs and stories to join in with
- Links to Francophone culture

### YEAR 4 BLANC

#### Phonics

- Revisit phonemes and encounter remaining new ones
- Read aloud short sentences

#### Grammar

- Build on prior knowledge
- Position of adjectives
- Negative sentence
- Plural nouns
- Question forms
- Elision

#### Vocabulary

- Vocabulary useful for sentence building
- Vocabulary to introduce new phonemes

#### Skills

- Listening, speaking, reading and writing (sometimes from memory) sentences
- Find meanings of words in bi-lingual dictionary for writing

#### Songs, stories and rhymes

- Join in with the words sometimes from memory
- Links to Francophone culture

## YEAR 5 ROUGE

### Phonics

- Revisit phonemes and develop understanding of grapheme connections
- Read aloud more complex sentences

### Grammar

- Build on prior knowledge
- Agreement of adjectives
- Definite article
- 3rd person singular and plural
- Elision - consolidation

### Vocabulary

- Vocabulary useful for sentence building
- Vocabulary to introduce new graphemes

### Skills

- Listening, speaking, reading and writing (sometimes from memory) complex sentences and questions
- Manipulate vocabulary in sentences
- Find meanings of plural nouns, conjugated verbs in bi-lingual dictionary for writing

### Songs, stories and rhymes

- Follow text of familiar song or story
- Links to Francophone culture

## YEAR 6 TRICOLORE

### Phonics

- Consolidate letter and sound connections
- Pronounce unfamiliar words with high degree of accuracy
- Liaison

### Grammar

- Build on prior knowledge
- Subordinate clause
- Agreement of adjectives in plural
- Familiar and informal - you

### Vocabulary

- Vocabulary useful for sentence building
- Vocabulary to introduce new graphemes

### Skills

- Listening, speaking, reading and writing (sometimes from memory) complex sentences and questions
- Manipulate vocabulary in sentences
- Decode unfamiliar text with a bi-lingual dictionary
- Engage in a conversation and give opinions

### Songs, stories and rhymes

- Understand gist of unfamiliar story
- Links to Francophone culture
