Please make a Christingle for Tuesday 9th December

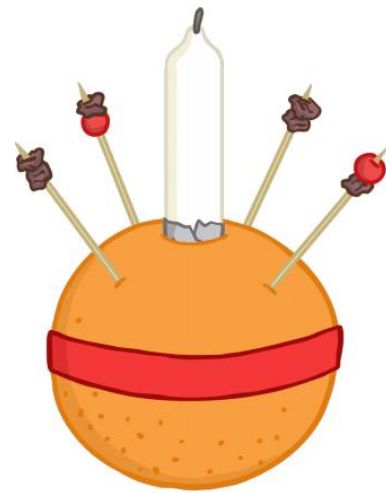
What is a Christingle?

A Christingle is a joyful celebration; celebrated during Advent. It brings the school community together to share the light of Jesus and spread a message of hope.

How do I make a Christingle?

What you will need:

- 1 orange
- 2cm by 2cm criss-cross slit in the top **NB: School will provide the candles.**
- 1 small piece of foil measuring 6cm by 6cm to catch the dripping wax (poke into the hole you have made)
- Enough red ribbon or red tape to go all around the middle of the orange.
- 4 cocktail sticks (adults to cut off the pointed ends)
- Soft sweets or dried fruit (please only use twelve pieces per Christingle)
- **Tip: slicing a thin layer of peel from the bottom of the orange or placing in a foil dish helps to steady it on the table.**



The symbolic meaning:

Christingle

ORANGE
the world

RED TAPE
God's love for the world



CANDLE

Jesus - he shows us what God is like

4 COCKTAIL STICKS
4 corners of the world

SWEETS
the good gifts God gives us
