KEY STAGE TWO NATIONAL ASSESSMENT RESULTS 2023

Below are the Key Stage 2 outcomes for 2023. There were 32 children in Year 6.

The expected standard in the tests is a scaled score of 100 or above. The scaled score range is from 80 – 120. Writing Teacher Assessment is not converted to a scaled score. The national figures are also shown in the table below.

Interpreting progress scores: Progress scores will be centred around 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to 5.

A **score of 0** means children in this school on average do about **as well** at KS2 as those with a similar prior attainment.

A **positive score** means children in this school on average **do better** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment.

A **negative score** means children in this school on average **do worse** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
