<u>Art and Design</u> Create a sketch of a famous landmark. Use your sketching and pencil drawing skills to add depth and detail.	<u>RE</u> Design a poster detailing the events of Pentecost and The Holy Spirit. Include facts and pictures to tell the story.	<u>Science</u> Go on an investigative walk and create a science report for different types of flowers and plants you see.
<u>Design and Technology</u> Create your own menu for a themed restaurant of your choice. It could be based on a type of food such as pizza, or based on a theme/country like Italian or American.	<u>French</u> Find out the names of as many animals in French as you can. Draw and label them.	<u>History</u> Research about any famous Ancient Egyptian. Detail your findings in a presentation. You can do this on PowerPoint, or a poster or ask someone to record you presenting your facts.
<u>Computing</u> Create a presentation using PowerPoint about an animal you would grow, based on our book 'The Boy who Grew Dragons'. Include pictures and labelled diagrams.	<u>Music</u> Research a famous musician that you like. What facts can you find out? Why do you like their music? Can you share the music with the class?	<u>Geography</u> Create a fact sheet about Volcanoes or create a survival advice poster for earthquakes.
<u>PE</u> How far can you run? Go for a weekly run and ask an adult to help you track how far you have run in 20 minutes.
