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Art and Design

Research the artist 'William Turner' and find about his famous landscape paintings.
Can you create your own city landscape drawing using one focal point?

RE

Look at the Beatitudes in the Gospel of Matthew 5: 1-12. Can you reflect on the scripture and illustrate it, showing what our homes, school and class would be like if we follow the teaching of Jesus.

Science

Show your understanding of the circulatory system by creating a presentation, video or information leaflet about the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

Design and Technology

Research famous bridges in the UK and around the world. Can you design your own bridge at home using the techniques learned in school?

French

This term we will be learning about the weather and things linked to getting dressed. Can you create a video or a small book to teach younger children how to say key phrases?

History

Can you visit The Imperial War Museum or Stockport Air Raid Shelters to find out more about the impact WWI and WWII had on our local area?
You could create a leaflet after your visit.

Computing

Play different Scratch games online and explore the different variables and sequences used.
