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English	Reading We will be using our class texts to develop our reading skills and answering a range of question types. Writing We will explore the texts below and write for a range of purposes to support our writing of both fiction and non-fiction. Texts – How to Live Forever and Letters from the Lighthouse Writing Outcomes – Instructions and Newspaper Reports/Setting Descriptions and Historical Narratives/Blank Verse and Sonnets Spellings – Spelling Shed – revision of KS2 spelling patterns and Common Exception (Challenge) Words English Skills – Revision of all KS2 grammatical terms including word classes, fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, model verbs, sentence types and use of apostrophes.
Maths	Place Value: reading and understanding numbers to 10 million, placing them on number lines and ordering them, rounding and negative numbers Addition and Subtraction: solving problems involving adding and subtractions larger numbers Multiplication and division: common factors and multiples, prime numbers, square and cube numbers, multiplying and dividing by 2 digits and solving problems. Fractions: equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators, add and subtract mixed numbers and multiplying and dividing fractions. Times Tables Children need to know their times tables up to 12 x 12. They can practice learning them on TTRS, chanting them at home or by playing games. Arithmetic Year 6 will complete daily arithmetic questions to improve their mental skills.
